- Multipurpose Building is in progress and there was discussion on design and other issues concerning construction. Also it was discussed about putting a cable up to prevent access to the area by trespassers.

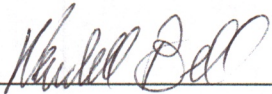
New Business:

- None

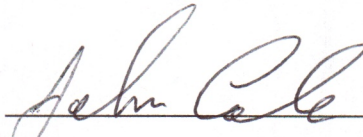
There was no Executive Session
