- MuniPay being used for the payment of taxes by credit card were discussed.

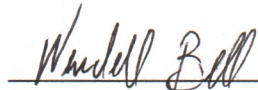
**New Business:**

- City Clerk is to contact Best Way Disposal to report this problem

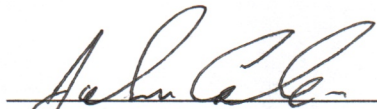
**There was no Executive Session**
